SPOTLIGHT ON ... CLIVE WILSON

What is your family situation?

Married to Pauline for 52 years. Have two children, a boy, and a girl and seven grandchildren. Both families live in the Eastern suburbs which has been a bonus for us.

Where did you grow up and go to school?

I went to Fyansford State School which had the total sum of 23 pupils. Throughout this entire period, myself & a girl were the only ones in our class. I came runner up to her every year. After grade six I went to Geelong High School which being on the extreme opposite side of Geelong involved a long bus each day.

In not sending me to a closer technical school Mum & Dad were obviously very aware of my lack of potential trade skills. I left after year 10 and commenced work the next January. Even though I did not obtain any subsequent formal qualifications some 25 years later I qualified myself as a "Bachelor of Experience".

What was your profession?

Joined National Bank in Geelong in 1960 and retired in 2002. Early days in the industry experience & progression were obtained by frequent movement & appointments to different branches. This involved me leaving home at 17 years of age and living & working in 4 country towns before being transferred to Ringwood as 1st Teller in 1965 at 22 years of age. As an only child one had to rapidly grow up to cope with the vastly different boarding & living experiences.

The next 37 years resulted in 21 separate roles 17 of which were in management or senior management and involved 14 separate locations including 4 years in Adelaide. One of the most significant instances over my career was while I was Manager of the Ormond branch, we were robbed 3 out of 4 Friday mornings at the same time each day. Whilst no one was physically hurt two younger staff members were adversely impacted and had longer term issues and health problems.

How long have you been a VSC member? What made you join?

Joined the Tennis Club in 1993 after returning from S.A. and buying locally. Nellie Sutherland, the then VSC Secretary, who we knew suggested I join and play Night Tennis with her husband Bob. The rest is history. Nellie also had a big influence on me being appointed to the VSC Committee in 1996. I subsequently became involved in Bowls around the turn of the century.

What other sports did you play before tennis and bowls?

Played a serious game of tennis at several Clubs in the various towns that I worked in. Had some tournament & Club success including being a winning member of the Country Week event at Kooyong in 1964. Also, played a "not so good game" of football up to my early 20's.

What hobbies or other interests do you enjoy?

Currently play and enjoy a social game of golf at Morack Golf course with up to 20 others each Wednesday. Handicap is growing each year.

Long standing member of Geelong Football Club and member of Melbourne Racing Club. Enjoy the races however, attendance has been restricted during Spring Carnivals due to my commitment to pennant bowls.

I am also Manager for 'Morack Racing Syndicate". This involves 6 mates. We have had a small share in a few horses over the past seven years. This has been a lot of fun with not surprisingly mixed success.

Which person do you admire most?

Whilst I have looked up to several identities over the years, I have to say the person I have the most admiration for is my wife, Pauline. Her consistency, loyalty, caring nature, commitment, and dedication to whatever she is involved in is first class.

Tell us something else that we don't know about you.

On our wedding day I forgot to ensure the best man, or I had the wedding rings. Yes, the rings!! So, during the ceremony we turned around and got married with a friend's rings. In the meantime, someone went to the house and picked up the rings which were subsequently exchanged in a further short ceremony.
