It was agreed we would work in partnership to encourage more participation from their families in our club. Outcomes of the meeting including a Jack Attack format for Sunday afternoon social with a sausage sizzle afterwards; a family day towards the month of Oct and the sharing of details of events occurring at the club

b)	Coaches meeting	An action item from the coaches/selectors/umpires' workshop was to have a further meeting of the coaches to determine what we will be doing over the winter season in preparation for our next Pennant season. Outcomes included ideally being able to select a person for the head coach position but if this cannot be achieved then having guest coaches over the winter season; utilising our nominated social bowls days to assist our new members to learn different aspects of the game and help them understand what happens in Pennant competition, by teaming them up with an experienced bowler; developmental forums every Saturday from 9.30 to 11.30; using an audit system to demonstrate progress and improvement and the Pennant performance assessment process being completed by the skip only, supported by a session on a skip's role and responsibilities. Mal suggested that the audit sheet be placed on a card similar to Pennant assessment cards.

The committee is very conscious of the losses incurred over the past 2 years and feel that we need to run what events we can even though the extensions might be underway.
