They were able to highlight the following issues:         <ul> <li>Poorly designed kitchen and failure to include an upgrade to a fully functioning industrial kitchen in our recent renovations' designs</li> <li>The issue of shade and shelter becoming a health and safety issue</li> <li>Positioning our club as a standout in Whitehorse for the future by having a dome cover.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	Council will compete a report and we will wait to ascertain any outcomes.
	(iii) The issue of the drains at the carpark entrance being blocked and flooding needs to be raised with Council. <b>John I to talk to Ken</b>
	(iv) There was a great turnup at the gardening bee and all the mulch was distributed. Thank you to everyone involved and an enjoyable morning tea was had by all involved.
