2)	Confirm Minutes: Moved: John Strybosch Seconded: Pam Barnhill Circulated minutes of meeting held 5 th February 2024, be taken as presented and adopted as a true record of proceedings. – Carried					
3)	Business arising from Previous Meeting and Current Matters	(i) Deb has advised she will be unable to continue with uniforms due to a personal commitment. We will need to get someone else to take on this responsibility. In the meantime, John S will get Debbie S to follow up the situation with the proposed supplier. The cost of the sample shirts and artwork has increased with a layout/redesign fee now included. The total cost is now \$352.00 plus GST. Look at just having one sample shirt made up to reduce the cost. Debbie S to follow up.				
a)	Pennant - John S	(i) We've had a very successful Saturday Pennant season with four sides playing finals. 1st and 2nd teams will play in grand finals this Saturday. The top side will have to win to be promoted. The second side will automatically go up. 3rd side finished fourth and the 4th side finished third. Tuesday Pennant – 1st team playing in an elimination final against Lilydale tomorrow. If they win will play again on Thursday. Thursday Pennant – 4th team lost their elimination final and finished fourth.				
b)	Social Bowls - Jann/Rhona	 (i) Because of the low numbers players are not being charged for Barefoot/Try Bowls and supper is r longer being offered. This will change after the current Jack Attack season when numbers are expected to increase and we see what response we get to our Try Bowls flyer letterbox drop. (ii) Di has lodged a submission to Council about more visible signage for the club – still waiting for outcome – Di to follow up – still waiting. Ken George would like the sign to cover Bowls, Tennis and Darts. Still Outstanding. (iii) New entry sheets for social bowls have been approved and will be placed in relevant folders for future use.

John to contact players involved. (iii) Because of above Presentation Day had to moved and will now be held on Sunday, 5th May. A short game will commence at 12.30 pm (will be free) followed by the presentation of awards at 2.00 pm. Nibbles will be served after the completion of the presentations. (iv) Ron Short and David Fisher playing in regional pairs competition. (v) Ladies Day – Kieser to step out to allow Glen Waverley to play. We now have too many entries for the event. Di to still work out the Vermont South teams. Play to commence at 10.00 am. We will provide lunch at the bell at 12.30 with nibbles at the end of the day after the presentations/raffle have completed. 100 show bags are being made up. There is an issue that the proposed fence at the front door of the building will not be secure enough. It will take eight weeks to supply and build a more secure fence. In the meantime a temporary fence to enable the building to be compliant and allow us occupancy will be erected. (iv) Data points not obvious in the roof and walls. (vi) As of last Friday the site manager still hadn't pressure washed the bank of the west green as promised nor moved the drinking fountain to the new position near the bottom of the stairs.
