3)	Business arising from Previous Meeting and Current Matters		
a)	Pennant – John	<ul> <li>(i) The club responded to Bowls Victoria regarding the later start to pennant on Tuesdays but their response pointed us to the Conditions of Play where you can negotiate a start time with opposition clubs. We will initiate contact with other clubs in our divisions to suggest starting at 10.30 am. A number of people have indicated they will not play if the games are to start at 11.00 am.</li> <li>(ii) There has been three members pull out of Tuesday pennant with the possibility of two coming in.</li> <li>(iii) We will stay with the number of teams we have nominated for pennant – Saturday -5, Tuesday - 4½ and on Thursday - 2. The ½ team on Tuesday will play triples.</li> <li>(iv) For Saturdays where the temperature is forecast to be over 36 degrees play is to commence at 10.00 am.</li> <li>(v) Final draw and Conditions of Play to be released by Bowls Victoria on 15th September.</li> <li>(vi) Live scoring to be completed by Division 1 and 2 on Saturdays and only Division 1 on Tuesdays.</li> <li>(vii) John is not going to hold forums on the new assessment system. Instead he will explain how it works before the players go out for each practice match. This should only take about 30 minutes but depending on how long it takes will decide the number of ends to be played.</li> <li>(viii) Teams for the practice matches will be displayed on the greenhouse wall. John must be notified of any unavailability for the practice matches either by the book in the greenhouse or by sending an email to John.</li> </ul>	

		<ul> <li>(ix) Bowls Victoria has advised they will be visiting clubs. We have not been advised of any pending visit as yet.</li> <li>(x) Goals and Strategies Meeting to be held tomorrow with 24 attendees at this stage.</li> <li>(xi) We have received a number of submissions for a catchcry which will be discussed at tomorrow's meeting. There has been concern regarding one of the suggestions so this will not be proceeded with.</li> <li>(xii) All practice games will be internal with the first to be held on Friday, 26th September (day before grand final) and then on 4th October. Opening Day will be on 11th October and the last practice game will be on 18th October. Pennant season to commence on Saturday, 25th October. Last round to be held on February 14th before the finals commence. Tuesday pennant to commence 28th October.</li> <li>(xiii) John has reviewed the Selection Policy.</li> </ul>
b)	Social Bowls - Peter	<ul> <li>(i) Jim Jones has volunteered to help Matt when he takes over as convenor of Saturday social bowle next year.</li> <li>(ii) Data analysis to be provided for the numbers playing social bowls during the week and the mone generated. Monday and Wednesday have around 40 plus players each week but Thursday numbers are generally much lower and can be as low as 12. Di will call a meeting of convenors prior to the start of each season to possibly look at a round robin comp instead of the usual formation.</li> <li>(iii) We have had a number of visitors playing social bowls.</li> <li>(iv) Need to establish what our members are doing during the break.</li> <li>(v) Monday Pairs was to finish next week but will be extended to the end of September with Kim, Jim and Mike doing the convening. Saturday social to continue until 20<sup>th</sup> September.</li> <li>(vi) Barefoot Bowls to recommence the first Friday in October.</li> </ul>
c)	Tournament – John/Mike	(i) Ladies Club Challenge on 5 <sup>th</sup> October – Croydon are still struggling to get 35 ladies. They have contacted Eastwood Golf to help boost their numbers. Di to have a meeting with Croydon contact soon to finalise numbers. Di to organise running sheet and catering to be arranged.
d)	Club Championships - Graeme/Mal/David	(i) Entries for Men's Pairs to close on 24 <sup>th</sup> September and for the Women's Pairs on 8 <sup>th</sup> October. Fi round for the men to be played on Sunday, 28 <sup>th</sup> September and the women on Sunday, 12 <sup>th</sup> October. Both finals to be played on Sunday, 2 <sup>nd</sup> November. Matt queried how the money will ge to the club when entering online. <b>Anne to check with Phil what the situation is.</b> It was suggested a paper entry be completed until payment situation is confirmed.

Paul to obtain quotes for the recommendations made and give to Di before Wednesday's VSC meeting.</li> <li>(iii) Craig to speak to Ken George regarding a further insurance claim.</li> <li>(iv) Shelter for players and bags from the rain and sun still an issue. Have received a quote for \$150,000 for a shade option.</li> <li>(v) A dome is high on the wish list.</li> <li>(vi) Still waiting on a part from overseas for the projection screen to be installed.</li> </ul>

Raylene Carr has been in touch to request a membership form.</li> <li>(ii) Currently have 196 members.</li> <li>(iii) Membership renewals have gone out.
